YOUR AGREEMENT WITH AMAZING JOURNEYS, LLC

By providing payment, you agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. The terms and conditions of this agreement cannot be changed.

Cancellation Policy: From the time of deposit until September 12, 2023, there is a \$200 penalty for cancellation. From September 13 – October 10, 2023, there is a \$450 penalty for cancellation. From October 11 – November 9, 2023, the cancellation penalty is the amount of the deposit. From November 10 – December 13, 2023, the cancellation penalty is 50% of the total package price including airfare, Iguazu Falls post-tour package and pre- or post-night hotels. From December 14, 2023 until the day of travel, the cancellation penalty is 100% of the total package price including airfare, Iguazu Falls post-tour package and pre- or post-night hotels. Cancellations made on the day of departure and "no-shows" will receive no refund. There is no refund in the event of interruption or cancellation by the passenger after the start of the journey.

Travel Protection: Amazing Journeys recommends you purchase travel protection. Information will be sent with your tour confirmation.

This trip is for you if: You like to be on-the-go when you travel. You are happy to be on the move with early mornings, full days and walking tours, sometimes covering 1 – 2 hours of walking at a time, over a variety of terrain from cobblestone streets to easy pathways. You can navigate hills and uneven ground and climb into various modes of transportation.

Flights & Transfers: International flights are not included and it is up to the participant to secure their flights. Domestic flights within Argentina have not been included with the cost of the tour. These will be purchased separately when registering for the tour. The cost of three internal flights is \$999 for the main tour. If you are joining us for the post-tour to Iguazu Falls, the combined airfare for five internal flights is \$1598.

You will be flying into and out of Buenos Aires (EZE) for the main tour and the extension to Iguazu Falls. More details will be sent to you with your tour confirmation with flight perimeters. Please do not purchase your international flights until you have received a confirmation letter from Amazing Journeys via email.

Transfers from the Buenos Aires International Airport (EZE) at the start of the tour are not included. We will be sending additional information for getting to our starting hotel at a later time. Transfers are included at the end of the tour from the domestic airport in Buenos Aires (AEP) to the international airport (EZE).

Twin Accommodations: Twin accommodations are available if you and a friend are traveling together. When signing up for twin occupancy, should one of the roommates cancel, the remaining traveling roommate will assume the cost of a single supplement. Standard cancellation terms apply to any cancellation.

Baggage: Regardless of what your international air carrier permits, each traveler will be limited to one checked suitcase weighing no more than 33 pounds. Wheeled carry-ons are not suitable for coach tours so we recommend you use a soft-sided backpack or shoulder bag as your carry-on bag.

Taxes & Gratuities: Taxes and gratuities have been included in the cost of the tour package. These include baggage handling (one bag per person), local guides, drivers and meal servers for included features. We are unable to tip the hotel staff on your behalf and we leave that up to you. Taxes, surcharges, visa fees and government fees are subject to change.

Passport and Visa: A valid passport is required. Passports must be valid for six months beyond the last day of the trip. Visa requirements for Argentina and Brazil change often. Currently, a Brazilian visa is required for those going to Iguazu Falls from the US, Canada and Australia. The cost of the visa for a US citizen is currently \$70 USD. There may also be a minimal processing fee. Details will be sent at a later date. Rates and requirements may change at any time. For those who are citizens from countries other than the US, please consult the Embassy of Argentina and Brazil in your country of residence for visa requirements.

Vaccines & Precautions: There may be required vaccines and recommendations necessary in order to travel on this itinerary. We recommend you visit a travel clinic or see your health professional. Requirements can change at any time. It is recommended you bring along an official government issued Covid-19 proof of vaccination card as countries and venues along the way may still require it and you may be denied entry without. Exchange Rate: In the case of currency fluctuations of greater than 3%, we reserve the right to adjust our pricing accordingly in order that we may be able to operate the tours effectively.

Fuel Surcharges: Should oil costs go above \$65 a barrel and our tour operators adjust the rate of the tours cost accordingly, we reserve the right to adjust the cost of the tour.

Payments: We cannot be responsible for cancelled reservations due to declined credit or debit cards. We accept all major credit cards, personal checks 15 days or more prior to the travel date, cashier's checks, and money orders (checks, cashier's checks and money orders payable in US Dollars).

Travel Documents: Thoroughly review the itinerary and tickets in their entirety. Verify all passenger accommodations, ascertain that all names are correct, and match the documentation that you will be using for identification. Many travel suppliers require pre-registration forms completed online or via fax. These forms must be completed prior to the trip; it is your responsibility to make certain this has been done prior to your vacation. Suppliers may charge a substantial fee plus applicable fare increases for changes made after the tickets or documents are issued.

We reserve the right to change the itinerary of the trip, delete and/or substitute cities to be visited, change the class of service and the mode of transportation, all without prior notice, to the extent that such services and accommodations offered cannot be supplied due to delays, unsuitability, mechanical problems, weather, change of ownership or other causes beyond our exclusive control. Any additional costs will be borne by you. We further reserve the right to withdraw the trip prior to the date of departure.

The rights and remedies made available under this agreement are in addition to any other rights and remedies available under applicable law. Your acceptance of any refund waives the additional remedies. Under no circumstances will we be responsible for damages in excess of the amount paid to us by you. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this agreement shall be determined solely by the courts in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and you hereby consent to the jurisdiction of said courts. You agree to present any claims against us within 30 days after the tour ends and to file any suit within one year of the incident, and you acknowledge that this expressly limits the applicable statute of limitations to one year. You will be liable for our attorney costs if you are unsuccessful in any legal action against us. You agree to grant us (and third parties with whom we may engage in joint marketing) a worldwide, royalty-free, fully paid up license to use your photographic, video, or digital likeness solely for our promotional and/or commercial purposes.

You are responsible for respecting the authority and following the directions of the tour guide and your Amazing Journeys hosts. We may exclude you from participating in all or any part of the tour if, in our sole discretion, your condition or behavior renders you unfit for the tour or unfit for continuation once the tour has begun (unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of tour services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment; in such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to a refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour). Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour. You must be 21 years of age or older to participate in the tour. You agree to indemnify and hold us harmless from and against any costs, damages, losses, or liabilities arising out of your actions or omissions.



Insurance and Credit Card Protection: For your protection, we strongly recommend that you purchase trip insurance. No employee of Amazing Journeys is authorized to vary or amend the insurance policy's terms.

Cancellation by You: We must receive your cancellation in writing. We will notate your cancellation date as the day we receive a written document in which you make this request. You may notify us by letter, fax, or email.

Please note that your decision not to travel due to State Department advisories or fear of travel will constitute cancellation by you. No refund or credit will be given for any unused features or early departures for any reason.

Cancellation by Us: We may cancel any tour at any time before departure for any reason without limitation. We may cancel if we deem the number of passengers signed up for a given tour to be insufficient to operate the tour. We will make commercially reasonable efforts to keep the itinerary as it has been published; however, the final itinerary may vary due to third parties' schedules, availability, and other factors beyond our control. We may in our sole discretion substitute services or goods of similar quality for any service or good stated in the itinerary. If a tour is cancelled, we will use reasonable commercial efforts to obtain refunds from the suppliers. Our liability is limited to any refunds so obtained, and we will not be liable for any other costs, damages, or refunds of any kind for any loss, delay, inconvenience, disappointment, or expense whatsoever in such circumstances. Failure to provide final payment will result in cancellation of your reservation, forfeiting any payments as per cancellation policy above.

Erroneous Pricing Notice: Amazing Journeys reserves the right not to honor any published prices that it determines were erroneous due to printing, electronic or clerical error.

Disabilities: You certify that you do not have any condition or disability that would create a hazard for you or other guests participating in the tour, and that you understand that health care standards, facilities, and services abroad may be different or even inadequate for treating certain health conditions.
