YOUR AGREEMENT WITH AMAZING JOURNEYS, LLC

By providing payment, you agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. The terms and conditions of this agreement cannot be changed.

Cancellation Policy: From the time of deposit until September 4, 2024, there is a \$150 penalty for cancellation. From September 5 – December 2, 2024, the cancellation penalty is \$850 for the tour and pre/post nights. From December 3, 2024 – January 2, 2025 the cancellation penalty is 50% of the cost of the tour and pre/post nights. From January 3 – February 3, 2025 the cancellation penalty is 75% of the cost of the tour and pre/post nights. From February 4, 2025 until the day of travel, the cancellation penalty is 100% of the cost of the tour and pre/post nights. Cancellations made on the day of departure and "no-shows" will receive no refund. There is no refund in the event of interruption or cancellation by the passenger after the start of the journey. Your decision not to participate on the tour due to State Department advisories, fear of travel, illness or any other reason will be deemed a cancellation.

Travel Protection: Amazing Journeys recommends you purchase travel protection. Information will be sent with your tour confirmation.

This trip is for you if: You're an on-the-go traveler – you don't want to miss a thing, walking and standing for 2-3 hours isn't a big deal and you're able to walk on a 2.5 hour walking tour at a moderate pace, covering several miles, hills and uneven surfaces. Walking 4 miles throughout the day is very doable and you can easily climb stairs. You can navigate hills and uneven/wet ground independently, climb up and into various modes of transportation including boats and raised safari vehicles and could handle changes in elevation as high as 6,000 feet. You can expect several early mornings and some longer days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. When traveling in Africa you will encounter warm temperatures. You will be climbing in and out of custom-built safari vehicles on a small ladder several times a day and traveling on bumpy roads. You must be in good health and prepare properly. This trip is not a fit for those who require assistance with walking or who travel on mobility devices.

Flights & Transfers: It is important that you not purchase airfare until you receive a confirmation letter from Amazing Journeys which will contain specific flight parameters. This tour begins in Johannesburg (JNB) with arrivals anytime on March 5 and ends in Cape Town (CPT) with departures anytime after 10am on March 18. Transfers are included. In Johannesburg the hotel provides shuttle services from the airport to the hotel. In Cape Town, Amazing Journeys will provide transfers from our hotel to the airport from our group hotel.

Twin Accommodations: Amazing Journeys does not offer roommate matching but we may be able to help! If you would like to be connected with others who are looking for a roommate, please send an email to info@amazingjourneys.net We can put you in touch with others who may have expressed interest so that you can discuss amongst yourselves. Please note – Amazing Journeys takes no responsibility for roommate matching and is unable to step in to settle disputes or disagreements that may arise. When signing up for twin occupancy, should one of the roommates cancel their reservation before the trip, the remaining traveling roommate will assume the cost of a single supplement. Standard cancellation terms apply to any cancellation. Please understand that the list of those looking for a roommate may be very limited.

Baggage: Regardless of what your international air carrier permits, each traveler will be limited to one checked suitcase (maximum 44 lbs) for flights within Africa. Wheeled carry-ons are not suitable for tours in Africa and so we recommend you use a soft-sided backpack or shoulder bag as your carry-on bag (maximum 17 lbs).

Taxes & Gratuities: Taxes, surcharges, and government fees are subject to change. Gratuities have been included on this tour and include tips for the tour manager, local guides, safari guides, game lodges, drivers, luggage porters and servers at included meals. Gratuities are not included for housekeeping staff in the hotels and tipping is at your discretion.

Passport and Visa: A passport is necessary to travel on this itinerary. It must be valid for six months beyond the last day of the trip. Visas will be required on this itinerary. You must have at least 4 blank pages including two full pages facing each other (not the endorsement pages in the back) in your passport to allow for the entry stamps issued for South Africa, Zimbabwe and Botswana. Please note that visa requirements can change at any time and it is up to the traveler to be aware of visa requirements. More specific information regarding visas will be sent as the trip approaches.

Vaccines & Precautions: Malaria prevention is required when visiting Zimbabwe and Botswana. Consult your physician prior to departure. We recommend you visit a travel clinic or see your health professional to be sure you are up to date on vaccinations needed for international travel. Requirements can change at any time. You can get more information at the following web sites: www.cdc.gov/travel or www.travelersvaccines.com.

Exchange Rate: In the case of currency fluctuations of greater than 3%, we reserve the right to adjust our pricing accordingly in order that we may be able to operate the tours effectively.

Fuel Surcharges: Should oil costs go above \$65 a barrel and our tour operators adjust the rate of the tours cost accordingly, we reserve the right to adjust the cost of the tour.



Payments: We cannot be responsible for cancelled reservations due to declined credit or debit cards. We accept all major credit cards, personal checks 15 days or more prior to the travel date, cashier's checks, and money orders (checks, cashier's checks and money orders payable in US Dollars).

Travel Documents: Thoroughly review the itinerary and tickets in their entirety. Verify all passenger accommodations, ascertain that all names are correct, and match the documentation that you will be using for identification. Many travel suppliers require pre-registration forms completed online or via fax. These forms must be completed prior to the trip; it is your responsibility to make certain this has been done prior to your vacation. Suppliers may charge a substantial fee plus applicable fare increases for changes made after the tickets or documents are issued.

We assume no responsibility for any personal injury, illness, death, property damage, or other loss, accident, delay, inconvenience, or irregularity which may be occasioned either by reason (1) any act or omission of any of the Suppliers (2) any matter beyond our exclusive control including but not limited to a delay or cancellation of a flight that causes the participant to miss any portion of the trip. We do not guarantee any prices or the quality of any services. We have no special knowledge regarding the financial condition of the Suppliers, unsafe conditions, health hazards such as diseases, epidemics or pandemics, weather hazards, or climate extremes at locations to which you may travel.

We reserve the right to change the itinerary of the trip, delete and/or substitute cities to be visited, change the class of service and the mode of transportation, all without prior notice, to the extent that such services and accommodations offered cannot be supplied due to delays, unsuitability, mechanical problems, weather, change of ownership or other causes beyond our exclusive control. Any additional costs will be borne by you. We further reserve the right to withdraw the trip prior to the date of departure.

The rights and remedies made available under this agreement are in addition to any other rights and remedies available under applicable law. Your acceptance of any refund waives the additional remedies. Under no circumstances will we be responsible for damages in excess of the amount paid to us by you. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this agreement shall be determined solely by the courts in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and you hereby consent to the jurisdiction of said courts. You agree to present any claims against us within 30 days after the tour ends and to file any suit within one year of the incident, and you acknowledge that this expressly limits the applicable statute of limitations to one year. You will be liable for our attorney costs if you are unsuccessful in any legal action against us. You agree to grant us (and third parties with whom we may engage in joint marketing) a worldwide, royalty-free, fully paid up license to use your photographic, video, or digital likeness solely for our promotional and/or commercial purposes.

You are responsible for respecting the authority and following the directions of the tour guide and your Amazing Journeys hosts. We may exclude you from participating in all or any part of the tour if, in our sole discretion, your condition or behavior renders you unfit for the tour or unfit for continuation once the tour has begun (unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of tour services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment; in such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to a refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour). Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour. You must be 21 years of age or older to participate in the tour. You agree to indemnify and hold us harmless from and against any costs, damages, losses, or liabilities arising out of your actions or omissions.

Insurance and Credit Card Protection: For your protection, we strongly recommend that you purchase trip insurance. No employee of Amazing Journeys is authorized to vary or amend the insurance policy's terms.

Cancellation by You: We must receive your cancellation in writing. We will notate your cancellation date as the day we receive a written document in which you make this request. You may notify us by letter, fax, or email. Please note that your decision not to travel due to State Department advisories or fear of travel will constitute cancellation by you. No refund or credit will be given for any unused features or early departures for any reason.

Cancellation by Us: We may cancel any tour at any time before departure for any reason without limitation. We may cancel if we deem the number of passengers signed up for a given tour to be insufficient to operate the tour. We will make commercially reasonable efforts to keep the itinerary as it has been published; however, the final itinerary may vary due to



third parties' schedules, availability, and other factors beyond our control. We may in our sole discretion substitute services or goods of similar quality for any service or good stated in the itinerary. If a tour is cancelled, we will use reasonable commercial efforts to obtain refunds from the suppliers. Our liability is limited to any refunds so obtained, and we will not be liable for any other costs, damages, or refunds of any kind for any loss, delay, inconvenience, disappointment, or expense whatsoever in such circumstances. Failure to provide final payment will result in cancellation of your reservation, forfeiting any payments as per cancellation policy above.

Erroneous Pricing Notice: Amazing Journeys reserves the right not to honor any published prices that it determines were erroneous due to printing, electronic or clerical error.

Disabilities: You certify that you do not have any condition or disability that would create a hazard for you or other guests participating in the tour, and that you understand that health care standards, facilities, and services abroad may be different or even inadequate for treating certain health conditions. You agree to inform us at the time you tender your first payment (or at such later time when you become aware of such a condition) of any existing physical or mental illness, disability, pregnancy or any other condition for which you may require medical attention or special accommodation during the tour. Smoking: Smoking is not permitted where roommate matches have been arranged.
